

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update April 1, 2020

This morning, the Texico Conference Executive Committee met by videoconference and voted to continue the current status of suspended conference operations through April 30 in accordance with guidance from governmental leaders and public health experts. This means that:

- Worship Services in Texico Conference Churches will be suspended through the end of April with our pastors providing online worship experiences and using digital methods to maintain connection with our members,
- Church Schools will continue to meet through online platforms for instruction and,
- Conference Office staff will continue to work from home in support of conference operations as they serve our members through phone and email communications.

With the increasing gravity of the progression of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) it has become increasingly evident that we must all do everything we can to minimize activities that could facilitate passing this infection on to others should we be carriers, even unknowingly. We are all anxious for this heartbreaking social challenge to be over and for this whole unprecedented experience to be behind us.
