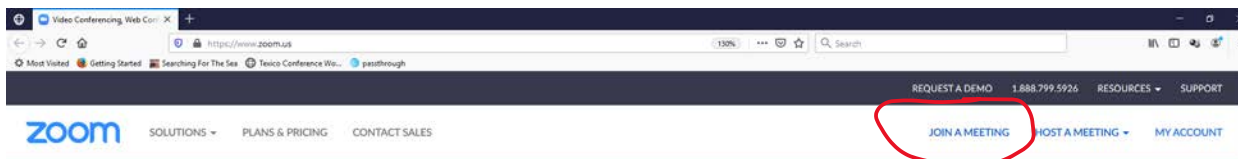
Dear Adventurers and Parents:

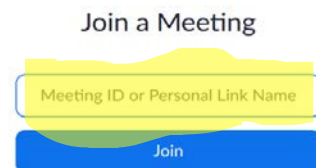

The activities will be Zoom led with times to be online and times to do an activity as a family. We are including a schedule to show you when you will need to be on the Zoom program. During the activities on Sabbath morning, you will need to have some supplies to use to accomplish the activity. We will e-mail you a list of what you will need for this. If you do not have all of the supplies or cannot get them, just substitute for different supplies or do a similar activity.

We will have four worship times with Pastor Joel Navarro presenting. We will be having songs and prayers that your Adventurers will be able to participate in at each of the meetings. If an Adventurer in your household would like to have a special music or a prayer (in English or Spanish) please indicate on your registration form. We want to have this as interactive as possible.

Since a lot of this will be online, you will have to have access to the internet on a phone, iPad (or other tablet) or a computer. The program we will use is Zoom. You need to go to [Zoom.us](https://zoom.us) and download it as an app on the phone or iPad or as a program on your computer. Each time you log in you will go to Zoom.us and click the "join a meeting" button.



After that you need to enter the meeting ID code that we will email you once we receive your registration form. Once you do that, make sure that you mute your mic and turn on your video. We want all video's on so the participants can be seen. We have had a problem with some outside people "bombing" Zoom meetings with inappropriate chats and pictures.



There will be times when we will have a group singing, but it does not work well with everyone singing with their mics on because of the delay. Therefore, when we have the group singing, please sing along at home with your mic off or muted.

We will be sending more information out before the weekend as well as during the weekend. That is why we need your registrations and e-mails as soon as possible.

We are looking forward to a spiritually fun weekend with the Adventurers and their families.
